Face Coverings

- Non-cloth masks must be worn in classrooms and clinical practice areas, including Student Health on Haven.
- Masks are strongly recommended for all other indoor spaces on campus.



Vaccinations

- The COVID-19 vaccine primary series plus one booster is required for all eligible students registering for the Fall 2022 semester.
- Flu vaccines are required for all registered students.

Access and Coverage



Student Health and Related Services Fee

Health and Related Services Fee (HRSF) grants students access to all resources offered through and at Student Health.

- Billed to all full-time students and anyone enrolled on the Aetna Student Health Insurance plan
- Full HRSF Annual Rate: **\$1,624** (Fall 2022: \$812; Spring 2023: \$812)

- In addition to paying the HRSF, all CUIMC students are **automatically enrolled** in the Columbia University Student Health Insurance Plan offered through Aetna.
- Students enrolled in the plan will not receive member cards in the mail; cards are available for download via the Aetna mobile app or Aetna website.

- Plan year coverage: August 15, 2022 August 14, 2023
- Annual premium cost: \$4,189
 (Fall 2022: \$1,596; Spring 2023: \$2,593)
- Bloodborne Pathogen Supplemental Fee:
 \$10 annually billed during the fall semester
 (Clinical students and funded GSAS students)
- Aetna Voluntary Plans include:
 - Voluntary Vision: \$65
 - Voluntary Dental Plan: \$455

Aetna Co-pays + Deductibles

Co-pays

- There is never a co-pay for services at Student Health on Haven including Medical Services or Counseling Services.
- There are co-pays for:
 - Specialist Visits: \$30
 - Urgent Care: \$60
 - Emergency Room: \$150
 - Generic Prescriptions: \$15
 - Brand Name Prescription: \$50
 - Specialty Drugs: \$75

Deductibles

A deductible is the amount of money that you must pay before Aetna will pay for claims.

- No deductible for in-network care.
- There is a \$600 deductible per policy year for out-ofnetwork care.

Aetna Referrals

- Medical Services is your primary care provider.
- You must obtain a referral from Student Health on Haven to see an outside specialist, including mental health providers in the community.
- A referral is not needed:
 - Whenever you are more that 50 miles away from campus
 - For routine OB-GYN care
 - To receive emergency/urgent care
 - For dependent children

Open Enrollment



All students must log in to the **Student Health on Haven Portal** to **waive** the CU Plan. To waive, you must meet the necessary criteria for the 2022-2023 academic year.

Before You Waive, Consider*

- Do I meet the waiver criteria?
- Do I have adequate coverage for occupational exposure?
- What are my current deductibles and co-pays?
- How expansive is my provider network?
- Do I have all the information I need to make my decision?




